From commissioning through to March 2020, the Solar Farm has generated more than 75,000 megawatt hours of energy and avoided a massive 60,000 tonnes of CO₂ emissions.

Council is successfully combating the impacts to its operational costs from rising electricity costs by taking a proactive approach to renewable energy.

Importantly, this initiative will strengthen the region's emerging clean energy hub, complement the 52,750 solar rooftops installed on the Sunshine Coast and attract other clean energy business investment.

Building on this work, council has moved into the detailed design stage of an education centre at the solar farm site to inspire and educate not only the local community, but the broader Australian community which has demonstrated interest in learning from our Sunshine Coast approach.
